Opening Ceremony of the Charity Shop Organized by the St. Philaret the Merciful Guild

Oⁿ Sunday, November 4, 2024 (Old Style), for the fourteenth consecutive year, the opening ceremony of the Charity Shop was held, which is organized annually as a fundraising activity by the St. Philaret the Merciful

Guild, under the protection of the Holy Patrons of our Metropolis: the Mother of God "Surety of Sinners" and the Three Holy New Hierarchs, whose Synaxis was celebrated the previous day (the first Sunday of November).
